UVic is hosting open houses on June 18th (at UVSS Upper Lounge) and June 19th (at Cedar Hill Recreation Centre) to provide some details on their vision for the space currently occupied by the Ian Stewart Complex and adjacent lands. Plans could include off-campus market housing and commercial space. This is your opportunity to learn more and share your thoughts. University District

Did you know that Saanich is undertaking a second process to borrow money?

The process is called an Alternative Approval Process (AAP). The current AAP is being undertaken to borrow up to \$150,000,000 for an Operations Centre Redevelopment Project.

The previous AAP process that completed in March was successful and council is able to move forward to borrow a combined total of up to \$9,615,000 for five separate projects.

The process of using an AAP means there is no need for a referendum.

We would like you to be aware that the process is underway and that the deadline for responses is 4:30pm on June 25, 2025.

If you support the borrowing then no response is required. If you are not in favour, there is a form to be filled out and there must be at least 8,735 valid Elector Response Forms returned to Saanich to prevent the adoption of the bylaw.
